INTRODUCTION

Participation is expected from QC, PE, NS and possibly from Maine. Biathlon NB will participate on a club basis – Charlo, Moncton and Oromocto. This instruction is only for the guidance of the club teams, all other information is contained in the official invitation for the event. MISSION

Biathlon NB will participate in NAC #5 and Eastern Canadian Championships with the three major regional club teams. in Charlo during 24 – 26 February 2006.

OBJECTIVES

1. To provide competition experience for NB athletes and coaches
2. To provide team leader experience for regional coaches at a major event
2. To win as many medals as possible

PARTICIPATION

All athletes deemed suitable by their regional coach may participate. Clubs may authorize as many coaches as they wish to take part in the event.

Biathlon NB/Biathlon Canada Membership

All participants in the event must be or must become members of Biathlon NB and Biathlon Canada for the year, at a cost of \$60 for Senior Boys/Girls and older and \$40 for Junior Boys/Girls.. The membership is required for insurance purposes and for the right to participate in the event. For athletes under age 18, the waiver portion of the membership application must be signed by a parent or guardian. The memberships application form is attached as part of this instruction – regional club coaches are to ensure that non-member athletes receive a copy.

Travel, Accommodation and Meals

Travel to and from the event and accommodation and meals at the event are the responsibility of the clubs for arrangements and costs..
