



## CANADA WINTER GAMES 2011 SELECTION TRIAL #1

18 and 19 December 2010, Charlo, NB

### INVITATION

#### INTRODUCTION

The first of the two selection events for the Canada Winter Games (CWG) 2011, Selection Trial #1, will be held at Club Les Aventuriers in Charlo during 18 and 19 December 2010. Conduct of the event will be in accordance with the Biathlon NB Team Selection Criteria and Related Procedures for CWG 2011 (short title: Selection Policy 2011). Trial # 2 will be held during 28 and 29 December 2010.

#### ELIGIBILITY

In order to take part in the Trials, an athlete has to meet all of the prerequisites and conditions set out in the CWG 2011 Technical Package for Biathlon and the Selection Policy 2011. All athletes who meet the requirements are eligible to participate. Athletes will be at the event as individuals, not as representatives of clubs or other organizations, and are responsible for themselves.

#### COMPETITIONS

The selection competitions at Trial #1 will be as follows:

FEMALE	7.5 km – 5 x 1.5 km, Orange P, S, P, S	7.5 km – 5 x 1.5 km, Orange P, S, P, S	30 seconds

**All competitors MUST carry a rifle in all of the competitions.**

#### EVENT PROGRAM

SAT, 18 DEC	0930 – 0945 1000 1100	Zeroing – all competitors Male Custom Individual 10 km (start interval 30 seconds) Female Custom Individual 7.5 km (start interval 30 seconds)
SUN, 19 DEC	0930 – 0945 1000 1100	Zeroing – all competitors Female Custom Individual 7.5 km (start interval 30 seconds) Male Custom Individual 10 km (start interval 30 seconds)

**Note:** The program may be subject to change depending on circumstances.

## SELECTION

Four female and four male athletes will be selected to the Biathlon NB CWG 2011 Team based on the sum of the two best results of the four (or minimum two) competitions in the two Selection Trials as defined and explained in the Selection Policy 2011. All selected athletes, regardless of age, will compete as Junior Men and Junior Women at the CWG 2011 competitions. In addition to the four female and four male athletes selected to the Team, one reserve athlete per gender will be selected as a replacement in case an athlete selected to the Team is unable to go to the CWG.

## COACHING SUPPORT AND WAXING


Competitors will be zeroed by the Biathlon NB coaches. A waxing protocol is being considered and the decision will be advised later.

## LOGISTICS

Athletes are responsible for their own travel, meals and accommodation. The Les Aventuriers chalet is expected to be available as accommodation for out-of-town athletes but has not been confirmed – information will be sent when it is known. Also, it is possible that there will be lunches for sale at the Chalet on Saturday and Sunday but it is not confirmed, the final decision will be advised.
